## The Local Government Pension Scheme Regulations

Notes on the Nomination of a Beneficiary to receive any Lump Sum Death Grant payable in accordance with the above Regulations

- 1. Scheme members may nominate person/s and / or institution/s, to receive any Lump Sum Death Grant payable under the Regulations.
- 2. The purpose of completing a Nomination Form is to ensure that, in the event of your death, any lump sums due are to be paid out in accordance with your wishes. This can of course also be achieved by making a Will. However, the *advantage of a nomination* is that because the monies do not form part of your Estate *Inheritance Tax cannot be levied* against them. You should note however, that if the sole beneficiary named in your Will is your married spouse Inheritance Tax will not be levied against your Estate.
- 3. You are advised to make a copy of any Nomination Form completed, together with these notes and keep them in a safe place. Whilst the Council must, under Pensions Law retain the right to override any nomination made, the purpose of a nomination is to help you make appropriate financial plans in the event of premature death.
- 4. You may change a nomination at any time, but you should note that each subsequent nomination will revoke any previous nomination made. If you wish to change a nomination in future, please contact the Pensions Section at Rhondda Cynon Taf County Borough Council, Bronwydd, Porth, CF39 9DL.
- 5. Death Grants can vary enormously, but as a general guide the following information may be helpful:-

Death in Service : Death Grant =  $2 \times Career$  average Pay

Death on Deferred Pension : Death Grant = Lump Sum earned to date of leaving

(i.e. having left employment with benefits deferred until age 60 / 65)

Death on Pension : Death Grants are payable if death occurs within the

first 5 years on pension. The amount payable is 5 x Pension less the

amount of pension paid up to the date of death.

- 6. If you have not already done so, you are advised to make a Will. This Nomination Form is designed to deal with a potential payment, which hopefully will not have to be made. A Will ensures that the rest of your finances are put in order.
